Loker University Student Union, INC. Public Lounge Policy

The intended purpose of public lounges is for the community to have a space to relax, study or do work, dine, and/or converse.

A public lounge is defined as any space in the Loker Student Union facility that is accessible to the public.

Private use and/or reservations in public lounges shall not be permitted.

The following activities are prohibited in public lounges:

- Blocking egress and or fire/life safety equipment
- The use of amplified sound or electronic devices with amplified sound (including, but not limited to laptop computers, portable players, streaming devices, cell phones, etc.)
- Conduct that is disruptive to others in the lounge and/or surrounding spaces and offices

Placement of furniture in public lounges shall not be rearranged by the public.

Individuals who violate the Public Lounge Policy shall be asked to leave and/or shall be referred to the student conduct officer or University Police.

Exceptions to this policy may be granted by the director or their designee.
